 the student provided an annotated score along with final paper
 the student added measure numbers (one per system) to the annotated score
 the student added formal labels to the annotated score
 the student provided a phrase diagram along with final paper
 the student's phrase diagram was complete and accounted for every measure of the music
final paper was double-spaced and in a 12-point font, and submitted as an MS Word document
final paper cited at least three different sources
 final paper followed a commonly used format for citations, and followed it consistently throughout
final paper had no more than one spelling error
 final paper had no more than one grammatical error
final paper had page numbers
body of the final paper was at least five pages of double-spaced text in a 12-point font when all
examples, diagrams, and extra spaces were removed
 paper ended with bibliography that adhered to a standard format and included at least ten sources
 final paper had a title page with the student's name and presentation title
 student's title indicated exactly what music the student was going to analyze
 student began paper with a paragraph that placed the music in a historical context
 student ended the first or second paragraph with a thesis statement
 student named the form of the music in the second paragraph, and provided a diagram with
measure numbers that outlined where each part of the form begins
 student discussed any stylistic features of the work not typical of the period
 student discussed any extra-musical influences on the composition of the work
